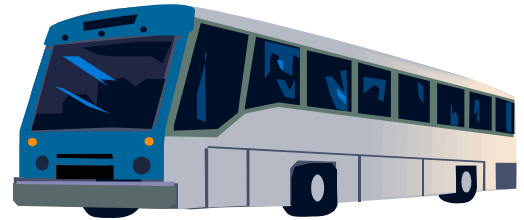


GRAD-BASH

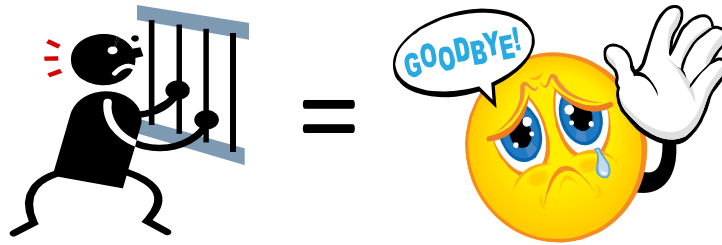


○ The policy is:

- The student **MUST** be a senior.
- They must have a 2.0 GPA and at least 16 Graduation Credits.
- They must have completed and turned in their Community Service Project by December 18th, 2013.
- A parent/guardian must have attended Senior Parent Night on September 16th, 2013 in order for the senior to receive a *Purchase Pass & Permission Form Packet* from January 27th – 31st, 2014.
- Purchase Pass Pick-Up information is available on our school's website and as a handout outside the Activities Office.
- The student must purchase his/her Grad Bash ticket on Tuesday, February 4 & 5, 2014 at 2:45 p.m. after school on a first-come, first-served basis.
- They must have met all of the requirements in order to purchase their ticket. Necessary requirements are posted on the school's website and available as handouts in the Activities Office.
- Students are not allowed to purchase tickets for anyone else but themselves.
- They must have the following in order to buy their ticket:
 - Photo ID
 - *Purchase Pass w/ Permission Form Packet*
 - \$129 Cash (NO CHECKS) EXACT CHANGE / NO COINS. Includes transportation, pre-party event with all-you can eat buffet and park admission.
 - If you do not have EXACT CHANGE, you will be sent to the back of the line and potentially lose your spot.
- Administration has the final say as to who goes and who does not go.
- We have ordered 4 buses therefore there are only 200 tickets available for students.
- The trip to Grad Bash will take place on Friday, April 4th, 2014. The bus will leave the school at approximately 12:00 p.m. and will return at approximately 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 5th, 2014.
- The *Permission Form Packet* will include the following forms which will need to be signed by the student and you, the parent/guardian:
 - *Parent Letter*
 - *Dress Code Contract*
 - *Behavior Contract*
 - *Student Bulletin*
 - *Field Trip Form*
- There will be police, security, administration, and teachers chaperoning the trip.
- We have strict guidelines set as to dress code and behavior. We will be checking students before they board the bus to make sure we do not have any problems. You must have your Photo ID in order to board the bus.



- Behavior: If for any reason, a student commits a violation at Grad Bash, please understand that Universal Studios will arrest and hold them. At that point, MSSH Administrators will not be allowed to bring the student back with us; the parents will have to travel to Orlando in order to pick the student up. Universal Studios and Miami Springs Senior High will not tolerate students who are caught using drugs, shoplifting, fighting, destroying property and/or committing other violations. There is heavy security positioned on all rides and throughout the park. In the past, students have mistakenly thought that they wouldn't get caught, but you can never tell who is a security guard and who is a student!



- Dress Code: The dress code has the girls either in dresses, skirts, dress pants/jeans and a blouse or a dress jumpsuit. Dresses and skirts must be fingertip length. Dresses and blouses can be sleeveless as long as the strap is a minimum of 2 inches wide. Spaghetti, halter, and similar straps are not acceptable, and neither is showing their stomachs. Universal Studios has assured us that they have clothing to put on you if you do not comply. We will not have that problem because we will not allow them to board the bus, so please let them know not to come inappropriately dressed or they will not board the bus. Boys need to be in dress pants/dressy jeans, shirt with collar or golf knit shirts that have a collar and is tucked in. No flip flops or crocs...wear comfortable shoes! Dress Code & Behavior Expectations will be specifically reviewed with those seniors attending Grad Bash at an assembly on April 2nd, 2014.



IMPORTANT: Grad Bash is the ONLY senior class trip sponsored by the school! Any other side-trips the students are talking about, are not endorsed, organized, or sponsored by Miami Springs Senior High School; that includes Halloween Horror Nights or trips to Cancun just to name a couple.
